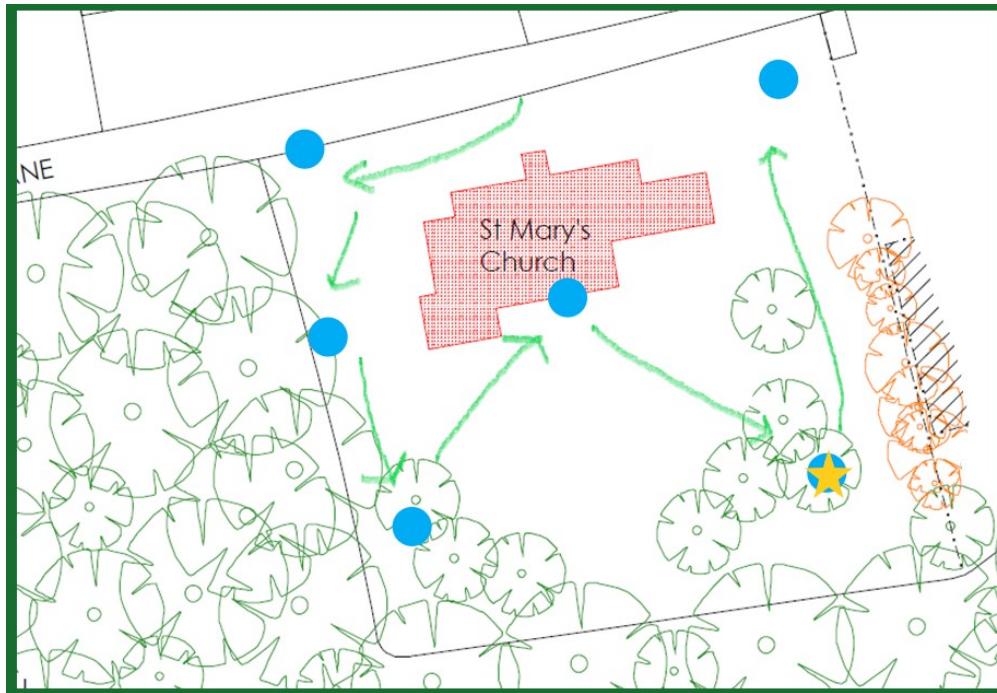


## Muddy Church Trail

There is a Muddy Church trail set up around St Mary's churchyard for you to enjoy. If you enter in the main gate of the church yard and turn right you will find six stations of things to think about and do around the churchyard. They are 'Leaves', 'Creatures', 'Weather', 'Movement', 'Stillness' and 'Paths'. Each is on a laminated sheet tied around a gate, tree or pipe. This is aimed at children and families but would be enjoyable for adults too!



The fifth station which is 'Stillness' is on a tree we have made into a prayer tree shown by the star on the map. The tree has rag bunting around it and we would love all, young and old alike, to add their prayers. Our suggestion is to write prayers of thankfulness to God for creation but any prayers are of course welcome. There is a bag hanging off the bunting which has in it a few pens and hand sanitiser but please do take your own pen and write on any rag that is hanging on the bunting, or even take your own rag / ribbon and make it even more colourful and joyous!
