*We say together*

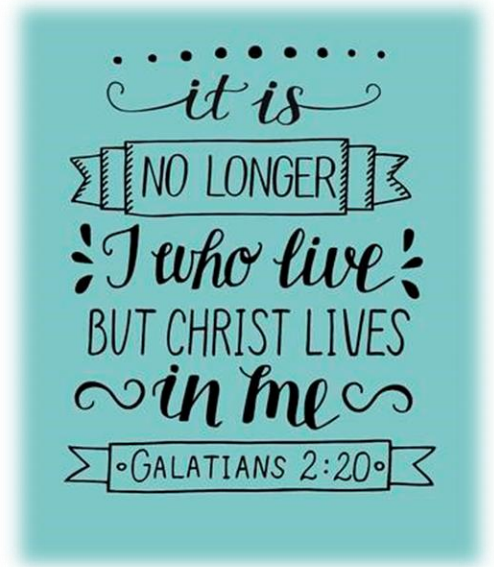
**Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name,
